



2026-2027 Avondale School District GSRP Application and Enrollment Prioritization Process

Phase One: Apply for the Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP)/PreK for All

1. Complete the MiECC online application: <https://version4.miecc.org/CaregiverPortal/63>
2. Upload the following:
 - Proof of age (four years old on or before December 1)

Phase Two: Following referral from Oakland Schools, the Service Provider (Avondale Early Learning Center) requires Avondale School District enrollment documents, additional Avondale ELC documents and attendance at a Family Meeting prior to enrollment in the Avondale GSRP Program. Enrollment may be delayed if all requirements are not met.

The Great Start Readiness Program does not have a first come, first served enrollment process. Students are enrolled on a priority basis as outlined below.

- **January 5 - Priority Enrollment:** Enrolling children up to **400% FPL** who will be four years old by **September 1, 2026.**
- **March 1 - Expanded Enrollment:** Enrolling children up to **750% FPL** who will be four years old by **December 1, 2026.**
- **May 1 - All Self-Reported Income:** Enrolling children who will be four years old by **December 1, 2026** without limit other than the estimated allocation of slots the program has available to fill.
- **August 1 - Final Enrollment Phase:** Enrolling families who do not provide a complete self-reported income form, and out-of-district families.

Priority is given to children experiencing homelessness, children in foster care and children with an eligible IEP.

Avondale Students with an IEP recommending inclusive placement, who are 4 years old by December 1 may be considered for placement in GSRP in consultation with the child's caseload teacher and the Director of Special Education.
